Five members had a pleasant walk in Spring sunshine through the mud of Priors Wood accompanied by the hammering of a Woodpecker and a few Peacock butterflies. The very first Bluebells were just showing colour and we recorded 20 species: nothing noteworthy except for a very late Scarlet Elf Cap. Just a single cup was spotted of this winter fruiting species. The Group has only ever found it later - on one occasion (22 April 2013) at NT Tyntesfield.
