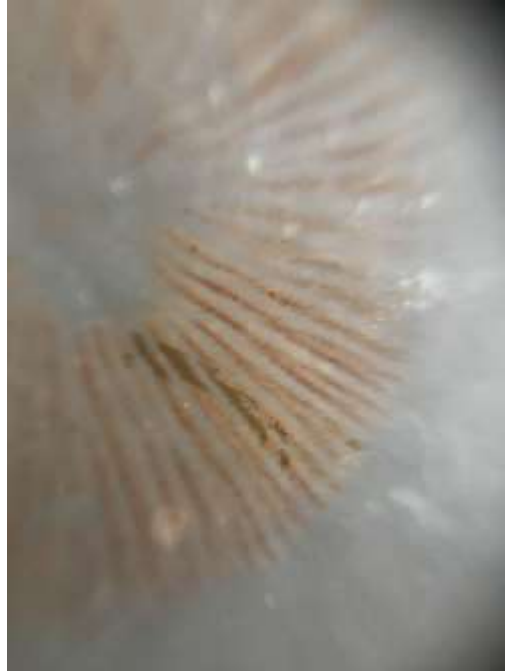


## Foray at the University of Bristol (6 Sept 2020)

***Bolbitius titubans***, a beautiful delicate species with a white cap, tipped egg yolk yellow. For faded versions, the presence of a densely pruinose stipe and pale brown spores are very useful characters.



***Clitopilus prunulus* – The Miller.** This is a very variable white fungus and can be quite confusing. It has a dry surface and decurrent gills, smelling of meal and has pale pink spores and gills. If in any doubt always prepare a spore print.



***Scleroderma citrina***. A common fungus especially on nutrient poor acid soils.



***Xerocomellus (Boletus) chrysenteron***. Cutting Boletes in half and recording any colour changes is essential for their identification. These images show typical response of *X. chrysenteron*. Coupled with it growing under conifers provides a confident identification.
